

Requirements for Reception of First Eucharist

1. Child must be baptized, and if baptized in a parish other than O.L.O.S., a copy of the baptismal certificate must be in our hands before the child will be allowed to participate in the reception of this sacrament. If Baptized at O.L.O.S., you must provide the exact date.
2. The child must be in second grade or older, and enrolled in the Religious Education program for one year prior, either in classes or home study, or at present attending Catholic School.
3. Child must attend Sunday Liturgy regularly with parent or other adult.
4. Child must have made First Penance, unless there is a good reason why they are unable to do so.
5. Child must prepare with parent or someone else for the reception of this sacrament. When preparation is complete and parent feels that child is ready, the Religious Education office must be notified. Without completed paperwork, your child will not be assigned to the group Communion service.
6. ***Child*** must attend Retreat Day, Saturday, March 10, 2012 at 9:00 a.m. *This is not optional.*
7. ***Parent and child*** must attend the Family Day on Saturday, March 10, 2012 at 12 noon
8. Parent and child must attend rehearsal for group communion on Thursday, March 29, 2012 at 6:00pm (for 10:00 Mass) or 7:00pm (for 1:00 Mass)
9. If the date of the group Communion is not convenient, or if for other reasons, you wish your child to make First Communion individually, the Religious Education office will set this up for you when all other requirements are complete.
10. Please use the Check List to indicate readiness, and return it to the Religious Education office.
